CO-SCHOLASTIC AREA

Following areas will be assessed -

i. Work Education - Computers

(No Pen Paper Test will be conducted for students of Std III to VI.
Continuous Assessment will be done on the Practical Activities)

ii. Art Education (Book prescribed by DAVCAE- STEP BY STEP)

iii. Health & Physical Education (Sports/Yoga)

(Students have to participate in any 2 sports activities in a year)

DISCIPLINE : This area includes Attendance, Sincerity, Behaviour, Values, Tidiness, Respectfulness for rules and regulations, Attitude towards Society & Nation. This will be again graded on a three-point grading scale **A, B & C**.

The following stages of action against misconduct by students will be undertaken depending on the degree and frequency of the offence.

Stage 1 Intimation of misconduct of the child to the parents :

- On observation by the teachers, of the misconduct by the student, the matter will be reported to the Coordinator and a detailed record will be maintained of the same.
- These incidents will be reported to the class teacher, who will then issue **WHITE CARD** to the student.
- The student will be detained from the class for half day or full day and will sit in the library.
- If these preliminary warnings go unheeded or with no corrective measures taken, then this will result in the matter being reported to the Principal and issue of a **YELLOW CARD**

Stage 2 A yellow card denotes 2 very serious reminders or warnings for gross misconduct followed by conditional grant of pardon.

- The student may be detained from class for 2 or 3 days and a **RED CARD** will be issued with a reminder.
- If no corrective measures are taken, it may lead to direct suspension from the school.

MERIT CERTIFICATE EXAM

To motivate students to excel in Scholastic(Academics) as well as Co-Scholastic(Co-Curricular Activities, Values, Attitudes and Behaviors) domains and make a mark for themselves as groomed all-rounders, the Merit Certificate will be awarded to the deserving students.

Merit Certificate Assessment Details:

- It is conducted once a year.
- It consists of comprehensive set of questions conveying Scholastic/Co-Scholastic aspects.
- It will carry 80 percent weightage for written assessment and 20 percent weightage will be awarded to interview.

Eligibility Criteria for the Merit Certificate Exam:

- The eligible student must score the highest score in the Scholastic and respectable score in the Co-Scholastic domain (Including Co-Curricular Activities, Values, Attitude, Behavior, etc), throughout the year.
- The eligible students will have to face the Panel Interview, Selection will be purely on the basis of merit. To be eligible , students must be present for all exams during the academic year.
