

Following areas will be assessed -


- Work Education** - Computer (No Pen Paper Test will be conducted for students of Std VII & VIII.

CO-SCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES

Co-Scholastic activities will be graded term wise on a **5-point grading scale** (A to E) and will have no descriptive indicators. Also, no up scaling of grades will be done.

Following areas will be assessed -

- i. **Art Education** (Art Book provided by School Faculty)
- ii. **Health & Physical Education (Sports/Yoga)** (Students are to participate in any 2 sports activities in a year)

DISCIPLINE: This area including attendance, sincerity, behaviour and values will be graded on a 5- point grading scale (A to E) and will have **no descriptive indicators**

MERIT CERTIFICATE ASSESSMENT (only for Std VII & IX)

To motivate students to excel in Academics and to make a mark for themselves as groomed all-rounders, the Merit Certificate will be awarded to the deserving students.

❖ **Merit Certificate Assessment Details:**

- It is conducted once a year.
- It consists of comprehensive set of questions to test the Academic and Co-curricular Skills.

❖ **Eligibility Criteria for the Merit Certificate Assessment:**

- The eligible student must score above 95% in final exam & the highest grade in all co-scholastic activities .
- The student should appear for all scholastic and co-scholastic activities conducted throughout the year.
- The eligible students will then have to appear for the Written Exam.
