**I. Periodic Test - (10 marks)**

**Parents are to note that Monthly Revision Tests are not a part of Internal Assessment. It is only to revise the concepts with the students.**

**II. Note Book Submission (5 marks)**

Note Book Submission as a part of Internal Assessment is aimed at enhancing seriousness of students towards preparing notes for the topics being taught in the classroom as well as assignments and revision worksheets. This also addresses the critical aspect of regularity, punctuality, neatness and notebook upkeep.

**III) Subject Enrichment Activity (5 marks)**

These are subject specific application activities aimed at enrichment of the understanding and skill development. These activities are to be recorded internally by the respective subject teachers.

**Languages** : Activities conducted in languages should aim at equipping the learner to develop effective speaking and learning skills.

**Mathematics** : The listed Laboratory activities and Projects as given in the prescribed publication of CBSE/NCERT will be followed.

**Science** : The listed Practical work/activities will be carried out as prescribed by CBSE in the curriculum.

**Social Science** : Map and Project work will be undertaken as prescribed by CBSE in the curriculum.
