Evaluations are done on quarterly basis based on overall performance

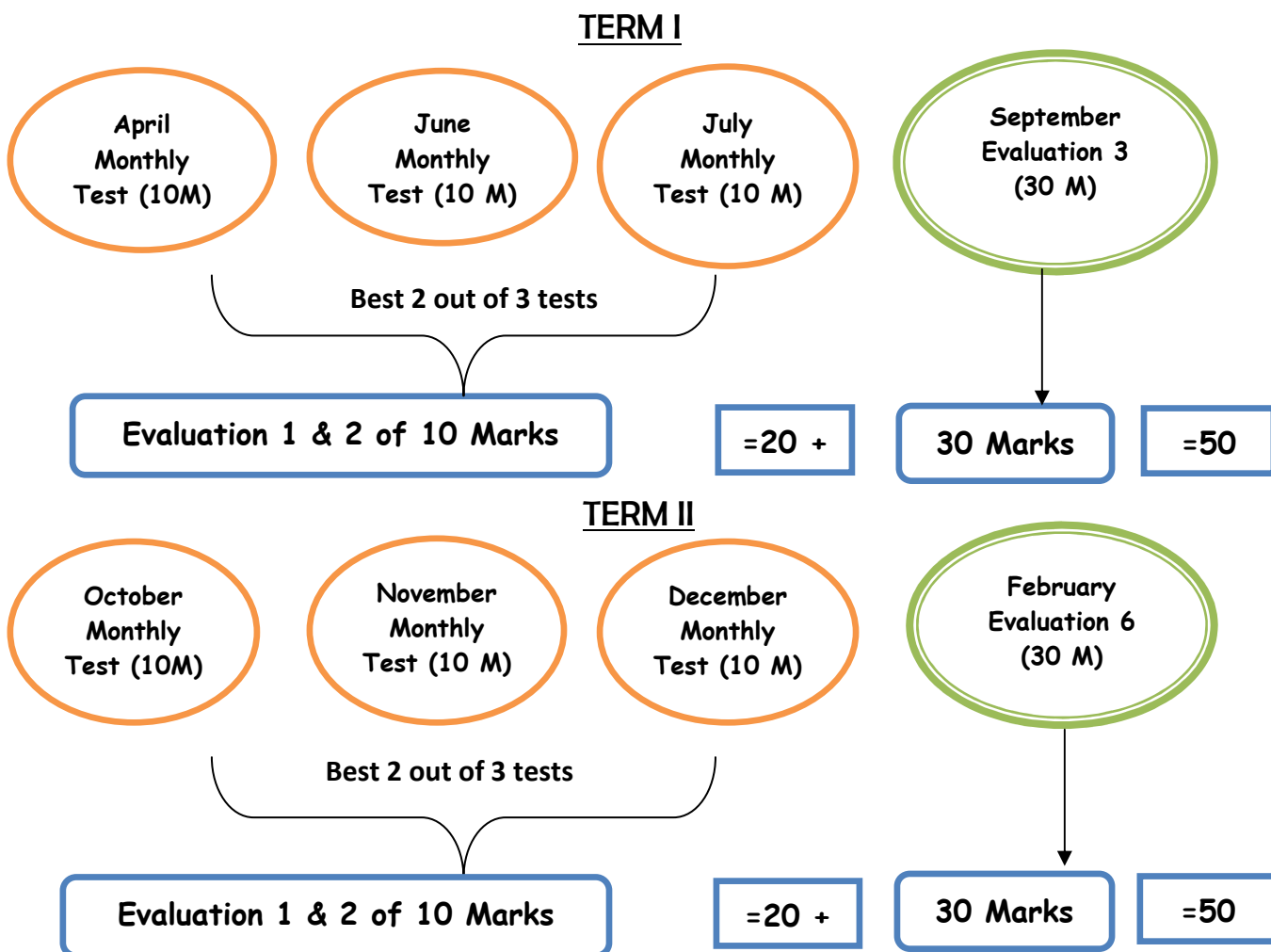
- Academic performance

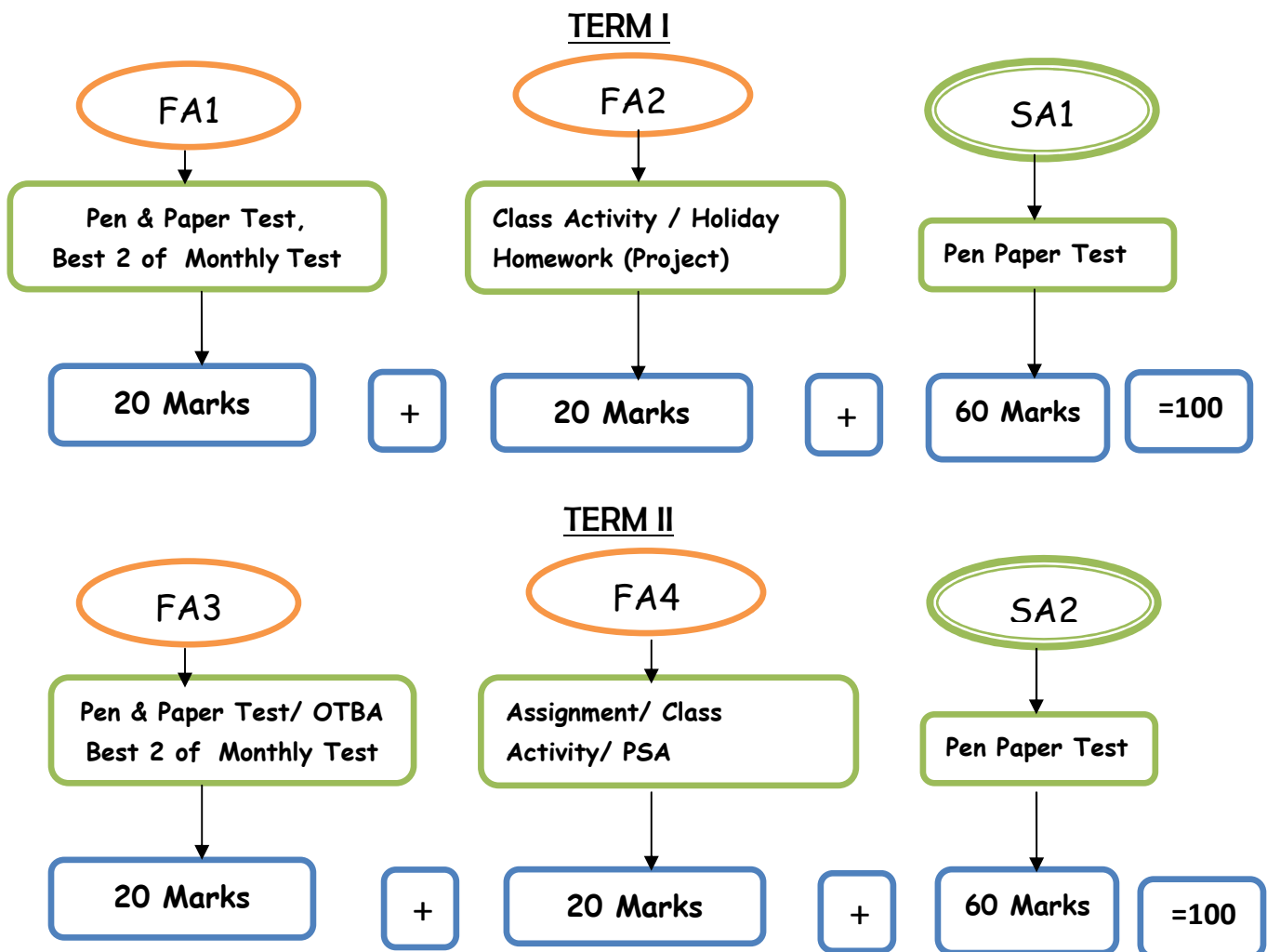
Evaluation Pattern for STD I & II



Rules for Evaluation

- The Academic session will be divided into two terms i.e. Evaluation 1 , 2 and 3 (Term 1), Evaluation 4, 5 and 6 (Term 2)
- The monthly test will be conducted only on the scheduled date and time.
- No re-exam will be taken in case the child is unable to appear for any evaluation and parents are requested not to approach the school authority for the same.
- No half days are allowed during the evaluation days.
- In the event of child falling sick during the exam days, parents are requested not to bring the child for the exam. However, the student will be evaluated on his / her class performance.
- The assessment for co-scholastic areas (Computer, GK, P.T, Art and Craft, ME and Music) will be conducted only twice in the academic year i.e Term1 (Evaluation3) and Term 2 (Evaluation6).

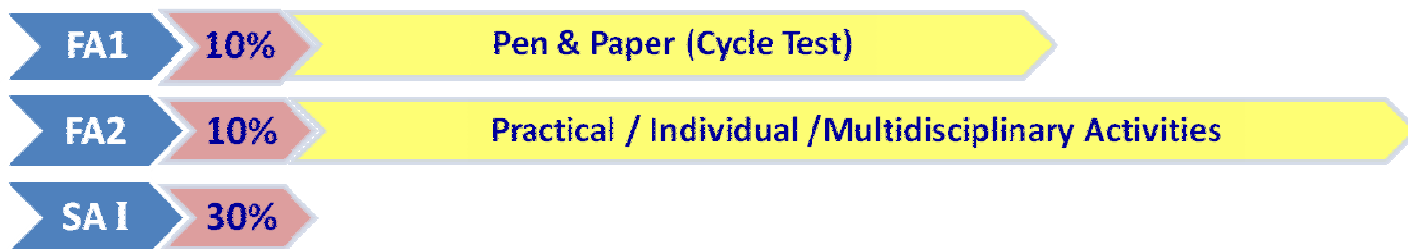

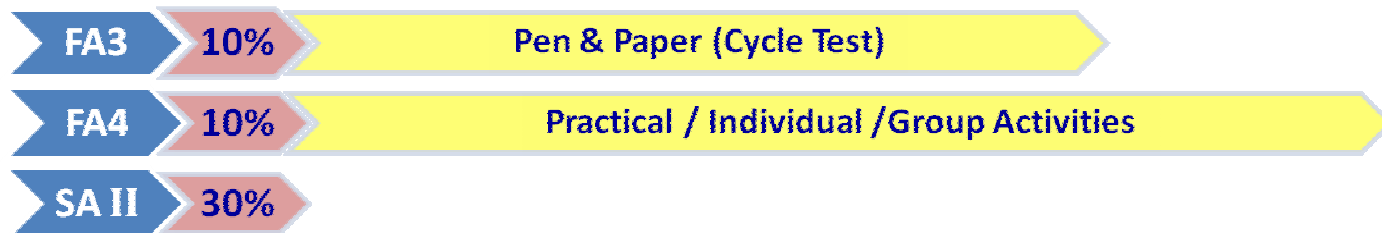

TERM I - 50%

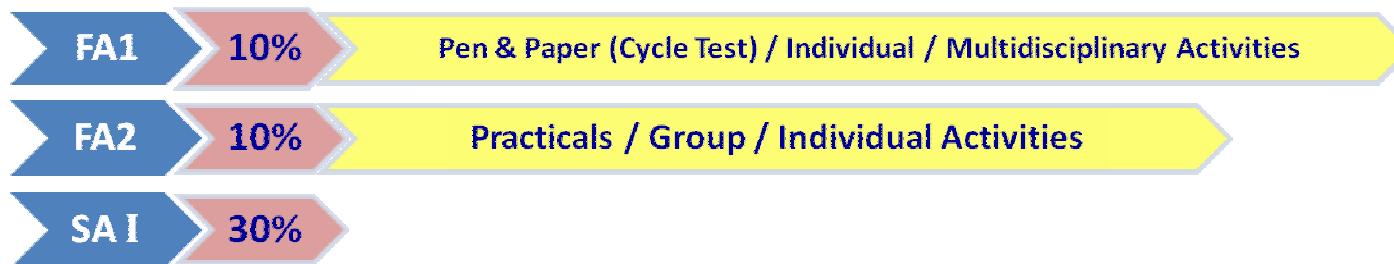


TERM II - 50%

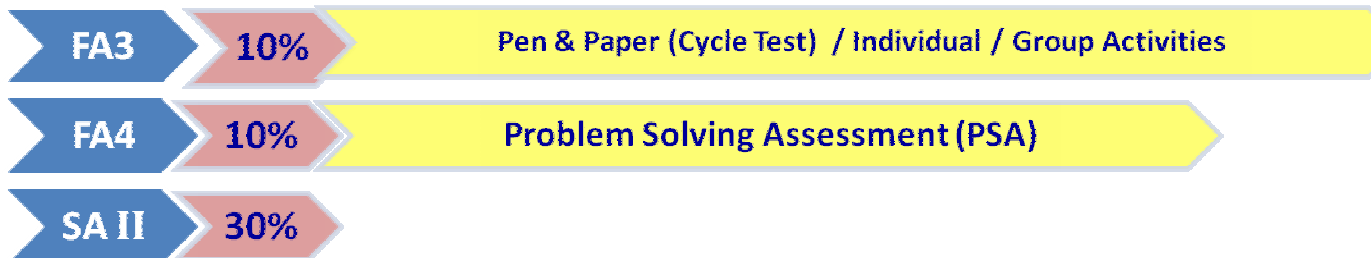


(STD IX & X) EVALUATION PATTERN
