Rules for Continuous Evaluation

- The Academic session will be divided into three terms i.e. Term 1 , Term 2 & Term 3.
- Each Term has three sets of Revision worksheets.
- The student will be evaluated continuously throughout the terms.
- In the event of child falling sick during the Revision Worksheet days, parents are requested not to bring the child to school. However, the student will be evaluated on his / her class performance.
- There will be no formal assessment for the Co-scholastic Areas (Computer, P.T, Art/Craft and Music). It will be a continuous evaluation through the entire academic year.

Rules for Evaluation

- The Academic session will be divided into two terms i.e Term1 and Term2.
- The Periodic Test will be conducted only on the scheduled date and time.
- No half days are allowed during the exam days.
- In the event of child falling sick during the exam days, parents are requested not to bring the child for exam.
- A child missing any exam, including graded paper will not be eligible for Merit Certificate Exam.
- The assessment for the Co-scholastic areas (Computer, P.T, Art/Craft and Music) will be a continuous evaluation through the entire academic year. The assessment for GK and ME will be conducted only twice in the academic year. i.e Term1 and Term2.
 - Portion for Final Exam for Std III and IV will also include **ONE** topic from Term 1.
 - Portion for Final Exam for Std V and VI will also include **THREE** topics from Term 1.

SECONDARY SECTION

(STD VII & VIII) EVALUATION PATTERN

1. SCHOLASTIC AREA

The entire academic year will be divided into two terms

1. Each term will have a distribution of 80 marks for Written Exam & 20 marks for Internal Assessment.
2. It is mandatory for a student to qualify Term I Examination by scoring at least 25% marks in Written Examination in each subject, to be able to appear for Term II.
3. Re-test will be conducted for those students who are not able to get qualifying marks at the end of Term I.
4. For Std. VIII, 25% of 1st term syllabus and entire syllabus of 2nd term will be covered in the final exam at the end of Term II.
5. For Std. VII, 20% of 1st term syllabus and entire syllabus of 2nd term will be covered in the final exam at the end of Term II.
6. Internal Assessment includes:-

I. **Unit Test (8 marks)**

II. **Notebook Submission (4 marks)**

III. **Project / Activity (4 marks)**

IV. **Subject Enrichment activity (4 marks)**

For languages - Speaking & Listening Skills

For Science - Practical Lab Work

For Mathematics - Maths Lab Practicals

For Social Science - Map Work & Project Work

The Internal Assessment will be conducted in both the Terms.

- For Std. VIII, DAV Centre For Academic Excellence (DAVCAE) will conduct examination at the end of each term.

2. CO-SCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES (STD VII & VIII)

- Co-Scholastic activities will be graded term wise on a three-point grading scale:-

A: Outstanding

B: Very Good

C: Fair

- Following areas will be assessed -

i. **Work Education - Computers**

No Pen Paper Test will be conducted for students of Std VII & VIII. Assessment will be done on the Practical Assessment Activities given in the Text Book.

ii. **Art Education**

iii. **Health & Physical Education (Sports/Yoga)**

3. DISCIPLINE

This area includes attendance, sincerity, behavior, values, tidiness, respectfulness for rules and regulations, attitude towards society & nation.

This will be again graded term-wise on a three-point grading scale **A, B & C**.

(STD IX & X) EVALUATION PATTERN

1. SCHOLASTIC AREA

The entire academic year consists of Half Yearly Exam (Term I) & Yearly Exam (Final Exam).

1. Each term will have a distribution of 80 marks for Written Exam & 20 marks for Internal Assessment.
2. Board will conduct Class IX & X Final Examination for 80 marks in each subject covering 100% syllabus of their respective classes.
3. Student has to score 33% marks out of 80 marks in the Written Exam & 33% marks out of overall 20 marks assigned for Internal Assessment in each subject.
4. Marks & Grades both will be awarded for individual subjects.
5. 9- point grading scale will be followed.
6. The 6th Additional Subject will be Vocational Subject (Information Technology). The Board will conduct Written Exam for 50 marks and Practical Exam for 50 marks.
7. Internal Assessment includes:-

I. Periodic Test (10 marks)

Three Periodic Written Tests in the entire academic year and the average of best two will be taken.

II. Notebook Submission (5 marks)

III. Subject Enrichment activity (5 marks)

For languages - Speaking & Listening Skills

For Science - Practical Lab Work

For Mathematics - Maths Lab Practicals

For Social Science - Map Work & Project Work

2. CO-SCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES (STD IX & X)

- Co-Scholastic activities will be graded term wise on a 5-point grading scale (A to E) and will have no descriptive indicators. **Also no upscaling of grades will be done.**
- Following areas to be assessed -
 - i. Work Education - SUPW
 - ii. Art Education
 - iii. Health & Physical Education (Sports/Yoga)

3. DISCIPLINE

This area including attendance, sincerity, behavior and values will be graded on a 5- point grading scale (A to E) and will have **no descriptive indicators**.
