## STD I & II



To instill in children the importance of our ancient values Shlok Recitation was given.They also told the meaning of the Shloka. It was a new experience

for all to recite the mantra online. Childen took part in large numbers.

The students learned the importance of Shloka and also its meaning. The participants were assessed on the basis of **Content, Pronunciation, Fluency** 

## and Voice Modulation.

This aim of this activity was to make the children understand that the teacher in the form of their **parents** or **teacher** in school play the most important role in their life.

They are the people who always think the best for them and motivate and guide them to do their best in life and overcome all difficulties with courage and a smile on their face.



Children took part in this activity with lots of enthusiasm. The participants were assessed on the basis of **Pronunciation**, Fluency, Expression and Confidence.

# **STORY TELLING – BRAVERY & COURAGE**



The aim of this activity was to make the children find and read stories of courage and bravery and realize that children also are brave souls and need not get scared or frightened of anything. It was to instill in the students the feeling of bravery and boldness. Many children took part in this activity and the response was huge. The participants were assessed on the basis of **Content** and **Language**, **Voice Modulation**, **Appeal to audience and Confidence**.



The students were encouraged to speak on any one of the themes (Guru Shishya Parampara or Kargil Vijay Diwas.) Their performances were judged on the basis of the content they had prepared, their pronounciation, the fluency in which they spoke and the voice modulation used while speaking.

Such activities always help to develop the vocabulary, their listening skills and overall confidence of the students. The students took part with great enthusiasm and it was indeed a treat to hear them come out with their unique points of view.



Songs and rhymes have a huge impact on child's language and literacy development. There are many students who have musical inclination in them and in order to help them to bring out this talent that lies within, the students were given a choice to express their feelings musically. Their performances were judged on the basis of their voice quality, range, sur/tal and expressions. Students enjoyed themselves thoroughly during this activity.



Stories when narrated in an interesting manner can help students to develop a sense of wonder about their surroundings. It helps them to use their imagination, appreciate and understand how people deal with different situations. It helps the children to become co-creators of a tale and thereby helps to develop their confidence. The students who participated in this activity were judged on the basis of the content and the language they used to narrate their story, their voice modulation, the appeal that they created in the audience for their story through their expressions and the confidence in which they projected the story. The class listened with all their attention as their fellow contestants narrated the story and appreciated them for their performance.

The activities were conducted until July 31<sup>st</sup> so that there would be maximum participation. The objective of these celebrations is to evoke a feeling of nationalism and patriotism with in students and when you see how wisdom has transformed your life, you feel grateful for all that come your way. Celebrating this feeling of gratitude is Guru Purnima. Our school conducted both the program successfully online and were able to achieve the set objectives and goals.
