Readiness Activity ;

Pre-writing skills are fundamental skills children needs to develop before they are able to write. These skills contribute to the child's ability to hold and use a pencil, and able to draw ,write, copy and colour. This activity help the children to build their self - confidence and improve an ability to exert force against resistence using the hands and fingers that allows the necessary muscle power for controlled movement of the pencil. In online class we have conducted this activity by drawing lines on the flour or rangoli powder to improve their confidence level and hand- eye co-ordination.









Colouring Activity:-

This activity was conducted to introduce the primary colours to the children. This will improve their fine motor skills, concentration power and hand –eye co-ordination. Children were made to colour the pictures which are in red colour , blue colour and green colour. Children participated enthusiastically in this activity, wherein they made beautiful pictures with different colours.



Paper Folding(Origami) :-

This activity was done to develop their fine motor skills.Children did this activity by folding the colourful marble paper and make a Paper Duck .Children stick this duck in their sketch book and decorate the page by drawing water, clouds,birds and colour them . Children participated enthusiastically in this activity and enjoyed this activity very much.







Games (Conversation) :-

Play allows children to use their creativity while developing their imagination , dexterity, physical, cognitive and emotional strength. Play is important for healthy brain development. It is through play that children at a very early age engage and interact in the world around them. These games are related to their lesson which in turn improve their conversational skills, self confidence and vocabulary.







<u>Yoga ;</u>

Yoga creates different cognitive ways for children to perceive themselves and the world. Meditation is a valuable skill that they can utilise their entire lives. It also offers psychological benefits for children as well. Yoga can improve focus, self-esteem, academic performance and classroom behaviour and can reduce anxiety and stress in children.
