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> D.A.V Public School Thane, is undertaking the initiative of enthusing patriotic fervour to celebrate and commemorate 75 years of independence and the glorious history of its people, culture and achievements, under the theme – "AZADI KA AMRIT MAHOTSAV".



The following activities will be held in the school under the Patriotic Club on August 12, 2022.

<u>Std 1 & 2</u> –

1) Role Play @ 75 Years (Theme- Freedom Fighters of India)

To commemorate the lives of our freedom fighters and to pay tribute to their sacrifice, struggle and endurance, Role Play competition will be held wherein students will dress like any of their favourite freedom fighter and speak a few lines on his/her characteristics or any anecdote from their lives. Time limit- 2 minutes. Language- English only.



2) Draw & Colour @ 75 Years (Topic- National Symbols)

Our National Symbols represent the Indian heritage and nature of India's National Identity. To mark respect and to infuse a sense of pride and patriotism, students will draw and colour any one National Symbol on a A4 size paper.

3) Poem Recitation @ 75 Years (Theme- Raksha bandhan) Raksha bandhan celebrates the beautiful bond of love and trust shared between a brother and a sister. To express gratitude, love and eternal peace to our brothers in Armed Forces, students will recite a poem with a message in English/Hindi. Time limit- 2 minutes.

Std 3 & 4 -1) Story Narration @ 75 Years (Theme- Freedom Struggle Movement)

Before Independence, many Freedom Struggle Movements took place like Jallianwala Baugh Massaacre, Revolt of 1857, Non- Cooperation Movement etc.. Students will narrate any Freedom Struggle Movement of their choice in the form of the story. Time limit- 3 minutes.

Slogan Writing @ 75 Years (Theme- India of My Dreams)

The youth of the country plays a great role in Nation-building. It has the power to help a country develop and move towards progress. Students will write creative Slogans as per the theme.

3) Collage Making @ 75 Years (India's Diverse Culture)

Children will use use A4 size paper and explore their creativity using newspapers, magazine cutouts and other decorative materials to portray India's Diverse Culture.

<u>Std 5 & 6 -</u>

1) Kavi Sammelan @ 75 Years (Theme- Zara yad karo Qurbani)-

Students will recite short poems on the sacrifice of Indian unsung heroes in Hindi.

3) Poster Making @ 75 Years (Theme- Cultural Diversity of India)

India has often been recognized as a country of unique and distinct culture. Students will make posters exhibiting the diversity of India.

Std 7 & 8 –

1) Essay Writing @ 75 Years (Topic- India- it's achievements in 75 years of Independence.)

To encourage children to write persuasively and present wellconnected ideas in a compact fashion, Essay Writing Competition will be held. Students will write essays in a foolscap paper.

2) Solo Dance @ 75 Years (Theme- Folk dances of India)

Folk dance reflects the traditional life of the people of India. Students will perform solo dance on any traditional folk song of their choice. Time limit- 2 minutes, Language- any regional song. Students will bring their songs in the pendrive.

3) Quiz @ 75 Years (Topic- Incredible India)

In an effort to expose young minds to the rich and diverse History of India, a guiz will be conducted based on Historical monuments of India.

Std 9 & 10 –

1) Solo Instrumental @ 75 Years (Theme- The Patriotic Fervour)

Students will play any instrument of their choice (Indian/Western). Time limit- 2 minutes.

2)Desh Bhakti Ke Geet @ 75 Years (Solo Vocal; Theme-Patriotism)

In an effort to awaken and strengthen the spirit of Nationalism, Students will sing songs (Non-filmy) based on Patriotism in Hindi/ English.











2) Poster Making @ 75 Years (Theme- Indian Art & Culture) To facilitate innovative thinking and extensive research work, Poster making Competition will be conducted on the topic- Indian Art and Culture). Students will be Chart Paper and other necessary decorative materials.

3) Group Discussion @ 75 Years (Atmanirbhar Bharat) To enhance communication skills and to promote the idea of presenting content with facts and accuracy, group Discussion competition will be held. Students will do their research work and prepare themselves accordingly.
