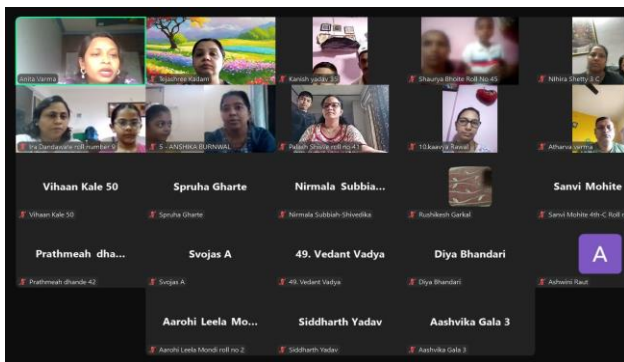


11.9.2024 (Wednesday) Personal Hygiene Day
