THE FORMATION OF THE PTA

Dear Parents,

Greetings!

This is to inform you regarding the formation of the **Parent Teacher Association** for the session **2026 – 2027**.

SIGNIFICANCE OF THE PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION:

The PTA is an integral part of the school management. It is a non-profit, non-political and non-sectarian organization made up of school staff and parents. The function of the PTA is to support the school in the development and improvement of the students in all possible ways.

WHO CAN BE A MEMBER OF THE PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION?

Criteria for Membership of the PTA:

- Parents whose wards' study in D.A.V. Public School, Thane.
- They should have completed a minimum of two consecutive years in the school.
- They shall be non-political, non-religious, positive, thoughtful, cooperative, accessible, open-minded and willing to contribute to the betterment of the children and the school.
- The parents, who were members of the Executive Committee once before, will not be eligible for the second term.

THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PTA:

- The PTA will meet when necessary but, twice per term compulsorily.
- Elected parents will be requested to communicate with the parents of that grade only.
- The member should be available to attend to the suggestions /issues concerning the parent body at large and take it up with the school for a satisfactory resolution.
- The member will be appreciated if they provide new ideas and suggestions to enhance the all-around education experience and work with the school for review and implementation of the same.
- Assist the school to arrange guest lecturers to give career and educational guidance to students, help in organizing events/activities for students etc.

WHAT IS NOT THE ROLE OF THE PTA:

- To get involved in individual complaints.
- Making any groupism or forcing individual opinions on others.
- To promote some personal, business or other activities.

ELECTION PROCESS:

The process of election will be conducted on the PTM (Parent Teacher Meeting) day, which is scheduled to be held on Saturday, 18 April 2026, for the Class Representatives who will be a member of the PTA.

STEP I:

Parents who are interested to be a member of the PTA can nominate themselves for the same by enrolling their candidature by informing the class teacher through their ward's diary.

The candidates must prepare an introductory video of themselves with a duration of 2 to 3 minutes. This video should be shared with the respective class teacher latest by **Friday 17 April 2026.**

No entries will be accepted later for any reason.

STEP II: Election for the Preliminary Phase:

The PTA body will initially require the election of two representatives (**1 male & 1 female**) from each division of **Sr. KG** through a fair process in the presence of the parents of the respective division.

STEP III:

The Parent Representatives to be elected will comprise of the elected candidates from the **Preliminary Phase**, with the highest number of votes.

The PTA body comprises **50% Parent Representatives and 50% of Teacher Representatives.**

Details of the Committee Composition:

Classes

→ ** (Sr. KG)

Teacher Representatives → ** (2 each from Sr. KG)

Parent Representatives → 2 (1 male & 1 female from Sr. KG A to Sr. KG E)

The elected members will be part of the Executive Committee formed in the academic year 2026– 2027 which is headed by the Principal as the President and the Secretary selected from the school staff. The Vice President and Joint Secretary are elected from the Parent Representatives of the Executive Committee.

The elected members shall be working for the Academic Year 2026 – 2027.

You are requested to kindly read and understand the terms and conditions given above before sending your name for the nomination.
