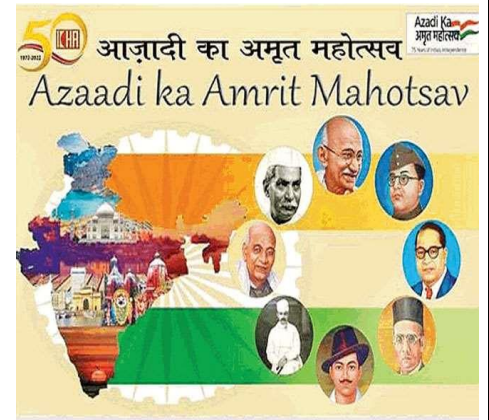


D.A.V PUBLIC SCHOOL, THANE
