SCIENTIFIC TEMPER

Scientific temper refers to an attitude of logical, rational and scientific thinking.

Scientific temper was first coined by the first prime minister of India, Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, in his book “The Discovery of India”.

It is an application of scientific method in day-to-day life which includes questioning, observing, physical reality, testing, analyzing and communicating.

India is the first and only country to explicitly adopt scientific temper in its constitution. Article 51 (A)(H) states that “It shall be the duty of every citizen of India to develop scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform.”

India has a potential in science. Many practices have deep-rooted scientific bases. Our ancestors followed the Ayurveda since ages. On contrary to it, a large section of our society is still caught in the quagmire of superstitions and irrational practices.

Inculcating scientific temper among its citizens is important for the development of nation. This is done during childhood while child is learning and responding to the events and happenings of everyday life. A person with scientific temper has curiosity to learn and discover. At an early age, kids ask questions about different things and they try to find the answers and discover new and important things around them.

To develop scientific temper in children, they should ask questions and also seek answers on their own. Use their reasoning and ask questions why, how, where, who, for the situations around them, which develops critical thinking and problem solving skills.

Perform hands on activities, experiments and find the scientific evidence for results and conclusions. Read and get information from encyclopedia and other references.

This extra reading will inspire their analysis of information. They are also exposed to logical and rational thinking behind events and happenings.

Solve more riddles and brain teasers to infuse excitement and challenge into analysis and problem solving. Play games like chess which helps in developing logical, sequencing and strategic skills.

Scientific temper help children to their attitude and way of thinking in different concepts and helps them to lead a systematic way of life.

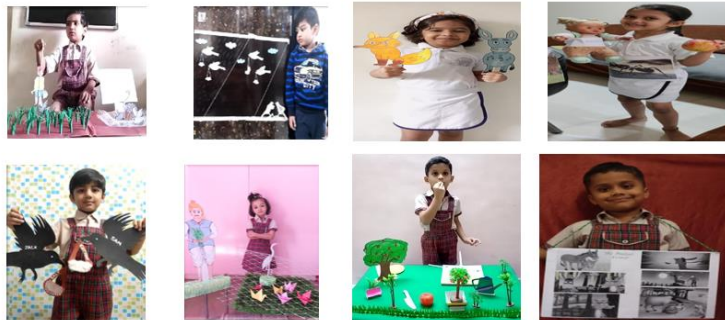

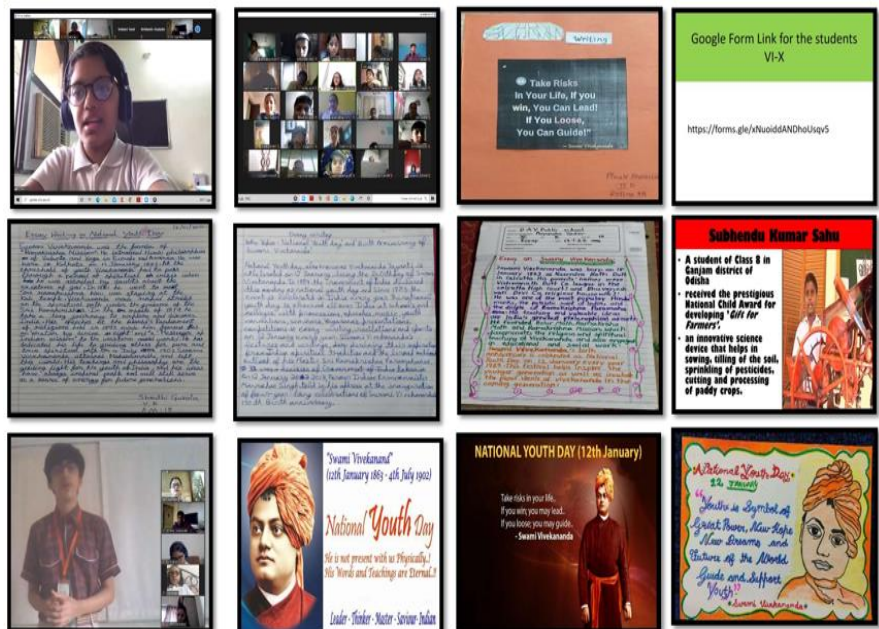


NATIONAL YOUTH DAY

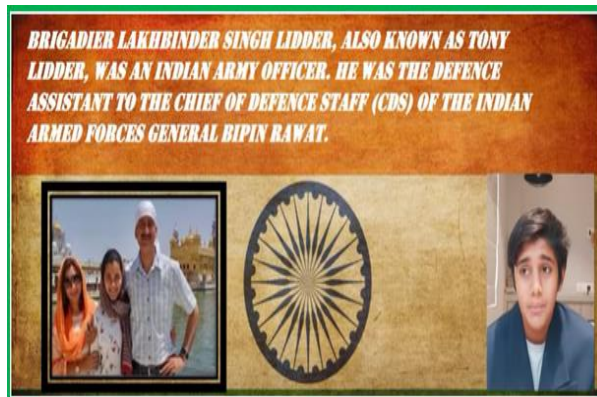
After this, students and Music teachers presented a medley of patriotic songs, in a very melodious voice
