Std. I–V

To nurture confident speakers and effective communicators, D.A.V. Public School, Thane organized a series of engaging **Oratory Club Activities** for students of **Std I to V** during the month of **July 2026**. The activities were conducted in the respective English classes beginning **20th July 2026**, with the objective of developing communication skills, creativity, critical thinking, confidence, and stage presence among young learners. Each activity was thoughtfully designed to provide students with an opportunity to express their ideas with clarity, imagination, and enthusiasm.
