If you've ever chanted 'Jai Hind!' and felt tremors of patriotic fervour, then you have Subash Chandra Bose to thank. School students across the country sang 'Kadam Kadam Badhaye Ja' song and the schools played the song during the assemblies today to pay tribute to Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose. To celebrate 125th birth anniversary of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose, a campaign, **#Netaji125**, was launched as part of Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav. The **#Netaji125** seeks to inspire the next generation with the freedom struggle of Subhas Chandra Bose.

On the occasion of **#Netaji125** and the establishment of the first Provisional Government of Azad Hind by Subhash Chandra Bose on October 21, 1943, in Singapore, the Ministry of Culture, Government of India, directed school assemblies to begin their day with the song Kadam Kadam Badhaye Ja...

To honour the contributions of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose a special programme was organised by **D.A.V. Public School, Thane.** Various programmes including discussions on Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose and Indian National National Army (INA) was organized to commemorate this auspicious day.

The primary aim of sensitizing the students about Subhas Chandra Bose, the most influential freedom fighter with extraordinary leadership skills and a charismatic orator'. He was affectionately called 'Netaji'.

He raised the <u>first Indian National Army (INA), Azad Hind Fauj in</u> <u>1943</u> and started an armed coup and inspired thousands of Indian youths to join the struggle for independence from the British colonial rule. His famous slogans are <u>'tum mujhe khoon do, main tumhe aazadi dunga',</u> <u>'Jai Hind', and 'Delhi Chalo'.</u> He is known for his militant approach that he used to gain independence and for his socialist policies. Netaji is considered by many as one of the greatest leaders ever born. Subhas Chandra Bose continues to be a symbol of assertive nationalism. The generations till date will remember the faith this great leader had in the youth and the potential to carry out positive changes for a longer time.

In order to honour and remember Netaji's indomitable spirit and selfless service to the nation Special online activities were organised, by playing song <u>'Kadam Kadam Badhaye Ja, Khushi Ke geet Gayeja, Ye</u> <u>Zindagi Hai Kaum ki Tu Kaum per Lutaye Ja</u>' to inculcate the feeling of patriotism.
