NERVES OF STEEL: NAIK DEVENDRA PRATAP SINGH

This year we celebrated 75th independence. On the eve of Independence Day, central government announced to honour heroes who sacrifices and protect our motherland. One of them is Naik Devendra Pratap Singh.



It was January 29 this year. The Indian Army received information that four terrorists hiding in a village in Jammu and Kashmir's Pulwama district. When terrorists were unable to get out of the house and got angry, they used grenades and left the house. Then a terrorist came in front of Devendra. He killed that terrorist.
